### **SIR FRANCIS DRAKE INTERSECTION PROJECT**

We will have our first public outreach meeting on November 15, 2011 at 7:00 pm in Town Hall.

### **CORTE MADERA CREEK BANK STABILIZATION PROJECT**

The project is substantially completed. Some winter planting work to follow.

### **BOLINAS AVENUE TRAFFIC CALMING AND DRAINAGE**

RFP's are going out to hire a consultant to proceed to the next phase.

### **POST OFFICE PARKING LOT REHABILITATION**

We received a bid from Nerviani Paving to overlay portions of the Ross Post Office parking lots. The bid also included installing two ADA compliant curb ramps at the crosswalk on the south side of the Post Office. The Public Works Committee decided to postpone the project until the downtown landscaping design was approved.

### **COUNTY OF MARIN SPECIAL OVERLAY PROJECT IN ROSS**

The County recently overlaid the path that runs along Allen Park from Kentfield to the Ross Post Office parking lot. A special thanks to Jack Curley for initiating the project and to the County road crew for doing such a great paving job.

### **SYLVAN LANE LAGUNITAS INTERSECTION**

Sylvan Lane residents have been invited to attend the meeting of November 8, 2011 at 4:00 pm in Town Hall with David Parisi who will discuss the traffic issues at Sylvan Lane and Lagunitas Road intersection.

### **AROUND TOWN**

- The County will be removing a large Monterey Pine that is lodged between the path and the flood control channel. They assessed the tree and deemed it a hazard. They are planning to remove it soon. They will notify us and give us the exact date.

- Our Public Works crew has been trimming and removing brush and debris along the right-of-ways, they cleaned ditches and catch basins to prepare for the winter days.

**BUILDING PERMITS, RESALE INSPECTIONS AND BUSINESS LICENSES**

In the month of October we issued 8 building permits with an actual valuation of \$369,149 and 5 plan-check permits with a future valuation of \$218,419. We scheduled two new resale inspections and processed 2. We collected \$646.25 in business license fees.
