

## Chapter 2.24

### BONDS\*\*

#### Sections:

##### 2.24.010 Official bonds.

2.24.010 Official bonds. The clerk, treasurer and chief of police of the town shall, before entering upon the duties of their respective offices, execute bonds to the town in the penal sums as follows:

- (1) The clerk in the penal sum of five thousand dollars;
- (2) The chief of police in the penal sum of two thousand dollars;
- (3) The treasurer in the penal sum of five thousand dollars.

\*\* For statutory provisions authorizing the town council to require bonds of the clerk, treasurer and “any other officer or employee of the city,” see Gov. C.A. §§36518—36521.

Such bonds shall be conditioned for the faithful performance of the duties of the respective officers; including in the same bond the duties of all offices of which the respective officer is made by law ex officio incumbent. (Prior code §2500).
