**RESOLUTION NO. 1648**

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL ESTABLISHING TWENTY-MINUTE RESTRICTED PARKING ON ROSS COMMON**

**WHEREAS**, parking spaces in the downtown business district are in limited supply and no spaces exist for parking of less than two-hours; and

**WHEREAS**, some downtown businesses are frequented by customers who require only short duration parking; and

**WHEREAS**, establishing two twenty-minute spaces downtown would promote increased circulation of parking for short duration customers.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Ross Town Council hereby establishes, pursuant to California Vehicle Code Section 22507, two parking spaces limited to twenty-minutes in duration between the hours of six a.m. and six p.m. along the west side Ross Common beginning five feet south of the intersection with Redwood Drive and continuing for a distance of forty feet.

It shall be unlawful for any driver to park or leave standing any vehicle in these two spaces for a period exceeding twenty-minutes between the hours of six a.m. and six p.m.

The foregoing resolution was duly and regularly adopted by the Town Council of the Town of Ross at its regular meeting held on the 8<sup>th</sup> day of May 2008 by the following vote:
