

Public Works and Building Department Report Council Meeting, February 10, 2011

SIR FRANCIS DRAKE BOULEVARD PROJECTS

1. Sir Francis Drake Boulevard Pedestrian Pathway

All of the Valley Oaks have been planted. The contractor is coming back this week to stake them. He will also remove one tree at #18 Sir Francis Drake Blvd, and plant the one they missed in front of #63. The pathway punch list has been completed.

2. Sir Francis Drake Boulevard Overlay Project

This project is now completed and the contract is being finalized.

LAGUNITAS BRIDGE UPDATE

This last two weeks we graded the planter area at the northeast corner of the bridge. We planted one Magnolia tree and three Redwood trees. Then we covered the entire area with mulch for erosion control. The project is completed.

LAUREL GROVE SLIDE PROTECTION

We finished installing the chain link fence on Laurel Grove to deal with the slide.

TREE PLANTING

Next week we will be planting two Magnolia trees at the bus stop park and one east of the Lagunitas Bridge.

FREDERICK ALLEN PARK UPDATE

- The Tree Man removed the Photinias and more brush around the courts.
- Robert, Buzz and Nerviani Paving removed all the bricks. They removed the asphalt and saw-cut a clean edge for the new landscaping. The area along the tennis courts has been rough-graded.
- We ordered the benches, the fence screening, the drinking fountain and the picnic tables.

#10 LAGUNITAS ROAD DRAINAGE PROJECT

We replaced the storm drain at #10 Lagunitas Road.

BUILDING PERMITS, RESALE INSPECTIONS AND BUSINESS LICENSES

In the month of January, we issued 10 building permits with an actual valuation of \$191,500 and 3 plan-check permits with a future valuation of \$425,000. We scheduled 3 new resale inspections and processed 2. We processed 105 business licenses and collected \$8,905 in business license fees.
