

Public Works Department Monthly Town Council Report June 2014

- 1. Completed annual cleanup along the road to Natalie Coffin Greene Park. Raised tree limbs to 14' above the roadway, cut back brush, removed poison oak and blackberries.
- 2. Conducted annual clean up along the U.S. Post Office path. Removed blackberries, poison oak and invasive brush and weeds.
- 3. Met Davey Tree about tree trimming on private roads on the Town west side; with Captain Carroll, Ross Valley Fire re: Oak tree that had fallen across the fire trail to Bald Hill. The crew cut up the tree and made the trail passable; and with various homeowners about tree issues in the right-of-way.
- 4. Repaired sprinkler leak on Bolinas Ave Island at Richmond. Repair work alternated with San Anselmo.
- 5. Replaced missing locks on backflow cages and electrical panels on Ross Common; replaced worn out Thermoplast markings in Natalie Coffin Greene Park and replaced worn out Stop bars at various locations.
- 6. On June 26th Public Works Supt. attended "Water Management Investment Strategy" meeting hosted by Marin County Flood Control and on June 27th attended "Creek Vegetation Maintenance meeting held at the North Bay Conservation Corps office in Novato. Marin County hosts training as part of the Marin County Flood Control Routine Maintenance Agreement. Participation in creek vegetation removal trainings is required due to permits with the California Department of Fish and Wildlife and other regulatory agencies.
