### **SIR FRANCIS DRAKE INTERSECTION PROJECT**

Caltrans approved the archeological investigation work at the locations defined by the Federated Indians of Graton Rancheria (FIGR). Public Works is waiting for proposal to authorize this work.

#### **BOLINAS AVENUE DRAINAGE & SAFE PATHWAYS**

Bolinas Avenue Advisory Committee meeting was held on October 29, 2012. Harrison Engineering is doing a presentation at this November 8<sup>th</sup> Council Meeting for the Safe Pathways project.

# **BUILDING PERMITS, RESALE INSPECTIONS AND BUSINESS LICENSES**

In the month of October we issued 18 building permits, 10 with a valuation of \$17,299.50 and 8 plan check permits with a future valuation of \$1,175,500. We scheduled 7 new resale inspections, processed 4 and collected \$2,475 in resale inspection fees. We collected \$460 in business license fees.
