SB407 WATER CONSERVATION FIXTURE COMPLIANCE VERIFICATION FORM

Effective January 1, 2014, Senate Bill 407 requires that as a condition of issuance of a certification of final completion for any permit for an alteration or improvement, the permit applicant shall replace all noncompliant plumbing fixtures within the building with water conserving plumbing fixtures. Non-compliant plumbing fixates are defined by SB407 as follows:

- 1. Any toilet manufactured to use more than 1.6 gallons per flush.
- 2. Any interior faucet that emits more than 2.2 gallons of water per minute.
- 3. Any showerhead manufactured to have a flow capacity of more than 2.5 gallons of water per minute.
- 4. Any urinal manufactured to use more than 1 gallon of water per flush.

State law did not allow sale or installation of any fixture that did not meet these requirements after January 1, 1994. If fixtures have not been replaced since January 1, 1994, state law requires that a plumbing permit must be obtained and the fixtures replaced before the Town may do a final inspection of any other permit.

A final inspection will not be performed until this form is completed and received by the building department.
