Subject: Appointment of Monique Predovich to Marin/Sonoma Mosquito & Vector Control District Board Member

Recommendation

Town Council appoint resident Monique Predovich to serve on the Marin/Sonoma Mosquito & Vector Control District Board of Trustees for the term May 1, 2020 to December 31, 2022.

Background and discussion

Town Council is asked to appoint Ross resident Monique Predovich to replace Paul Sagues, whose term on the Board expired December 31, 2019. Ms. Predovich had indicated her interest and willingness to serve on the Board.

The District Board has stipulated that it is no longer mandated that Ross appoint a representative to the Board, however, most other Marin jurisdictions currently are represented on the Board. It is the intent of the Legislature that persons appointed to Boards of Trustees have experience, training, and education in fields that will assist in the governance of the District. Anyone appointed must be a resident of Ross and a registered voter.

Dear Town Clerk:

The current term of Paul Sagues, the Town of Ross representative to our District's Board of Trustees, expires December 31, 2019. While it is no longer mandated that you appoint a representative to our Board {Health and Safety Code SB 1588, Article 3, Section 2022 (d)}, it is the intent of the Legislature that persons appointed to Boards of Trustees have experience, training, and education in fields that will assist in the governance of the District.

The following information is sent to assist your elected officials in the appointment process. California Health and Safety Code SB 1588

Section 2022 (a) *Each person appointed by a board of supervisors to be a member of a board of trustees shall be a voter in that county and a resident of that portion of the county that is within the district.*

Section 2024 (a) *The term of office for a member of the board of trustees shall be for a term of two (2) or four (4) years at the discretion of the appointing authority.*

Section 2023 (c) *At the first meeting of the initial board of trustees, the trustees shall classify themselves by lot into two classes, as nearly equal as possible. The term of office of the class having the greater number shall expire at noon on the first Monday in January that is closest to the second year from the appointments made pursuant to Section 2021. The term of office of the class having the lesser number shall expire at noon on the first Monday in January that is closest to the first year from the appointments made pursuant to Section 2021.*
